Section 426

CONFIDENTIALITY

- 426 [1] This section applies to a person-
- [a] iii A minister or an accredited representative , of a religious denomination or society mentioned in section 76[1]
- [b] who, in that capacity, has gained or has access to personal information about
- [i] a student, prospective student or former student of a state school or
- [ii] a pre preparatory age child
- [iii] a person with a disability
- [4] This person must not make a record of the information, use the information or disclose the information to anyone else other than-
- a. for the purpose of this Act
- b. with the consent of the person to whom the information relates[or if the person is a child unable to consent, with the consent of the parent of the child: or
- c. in compliance with lawful processes
- d. as permitted or required by another Act; or
- e. with the written consent of the chief executive

Personal Information means information or an opinion whether true or not, about an individual whose identity is apparent, or can reasonably be ascertained from the information or opinion
